



How do I clear my computer's cache?

Here are the steps you can take to clear your computer's cache:

Microsoft® Windows OS	
Internet Explorer 8 and 9	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on Tools.2. Choose Delete Browsing History.3. Deselect Preserve Favorites website data, and select Temporary Internet files, Cookies, and History.4. Click on "Delete".
Internet Explorer 7	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on Tools.2. Choose Internet Options.3. Click on "Delete..." in the Browsing History section.4. Click on "Delete Files" at the top and then click on OK.5. After it has finished, click OK.
Firefox 2.x	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on Tools.2. Select Clear Private Data.3. Make sure that the only options selected are Download History and Cache.4. Click on Clear Private Data Now.
Firefox 1.5 and 1.0	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. From the Tools menu, select Options.2. Click on Privacy.3. In 1.5, select the Cache tab, and then click the Clear Cache Now button. In 1.0, next to Cache, click the Clear button, and then click OK.
Netscape 7.1 and higher	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on Tools (located at the top of the browser).2. Choose Options, and then Click on Privacy.3. Click on Cache, and then click on Clear.
Google Chrome	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on  (located at the top right of the browser).2. Choose Tools, and then Click on Clear browsing data.3. Select on Empty the cache, and then click on Clear browsing data.
Mac® OS	
Safari	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. From the Safari menu, select Empty Cache.2. When prompted, click Empty.
Firefox 1.x and higher	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. From the Firefox menu, select Preferences.2. From the drop-down menu, select Privacy.3. In 1.5, click Clear Cache Now. In 1.0, next to Cache, click the Clear button, and then OK.
Netscape 7.1 and higher	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on Netscape at the top.2. Click on Preferences.3. Click on the triangle next to Advanced on the left.4. Click on Cache.5. Click on Clear Cache.
Google Chrome	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click on  (located at the top right of the browser).2. Choose Tools, and then Click on Clear browsing data.3. Select on Empty the cache, and then click on Clear browsing data.
